What is Jersey Cheshire Home?

Jersey Cheshire Home cares for physically disabled people aged 18 and over with a range of complex conditions such as neurological and degenerative conditions that have no cure; resulting in them no longer being able to live in their own home.

We offer quality care based on respect, compassion, love and kindness.

Residents stay with us for as long as they need care. The average stay is 15 years; however some residents have been in our care for over 30 years.

Jersey Cheshire Home's purpose-built facility can accommodate 30 full time residents. We offer additional services in the form of aqua therapy and physiotherapy enabling us to help well over 60 additional individuals each week to manage and improve their conditions.

We also support individuals and families with day care. Our day care is designed to meet the needs of those individuals within the disabled community who, whilst able to live in their own home, may have difficulty performing activities of day to day living. Day care benefits the individual by not only providing a change of environment but also the ability to socialise and meet new people.

It costs over £3 million to operate Jersey Cheshire Home. That is £250,000 a month or just over £8,300 a day.

Therapeutic Activities

We have an agua therapy pool, maintained at a constant 35 degrees Celsius with access ramps and a poolside hoist.



Home from Home

Our purpose-built home means accessibility is never an issue, we have state of the art en suite rooms to meet a variety of needs.



Sensory Room

Our sensory room has been specially designed to gently stimulate the senses, helping to reduce an individuals fears and enhance trust with carers.



Our fully equipped gym features advanced equipment specifically designed to benefit those with disabilities, such as multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's, spina bifida, stroke and head injuries.



Quality Care

We have highly skilled Registered Nurses and Health Care Assistants passionate about delivering quality care to disabled islanders.

We arrange many games, activites, outings and shopping trips to ensure residents' needs are catered for.



ENHANCING DINING EXPERIENCE

To create a more positive dining experience for our residents and to future proof our kitchens and equipment.

We need financial support to deliver a supportive dining environment for our residents; we wish to offer a more personal controlled experience to our residents.
